

Prof William Jeffcoate

was first appointed consultant endocrinologist in Nottingham, UK, in 1979. Much of his early research was concerned with non-diabetes endocrinology but the work load of clinical diabetes meant that his research interests slowly shifted in that direction, and to the diabetic foot in particular. He established one of the first ever multidisciplinary clinics for foot disease in 1982 and set up the Foot Ulcer Trials Unit in Nottingham in 2002. Together with Professor Game he has successfully completed a number of large multicentre trials of treatments and he has published extensively — mainly on the reasons why the evidence base for clinical care of the diabetic foot is so weak. He also drew attention to the importance of inflammation in the Charcot foot in a Hypothesis published in The Lancet in 2005. He is currently Clinical Lead of the National Foot Care Audit of England and Wales.
